

SERBIA - BOSNIA – CROATIA – MONTENEGRO

10 DAYS / 09 NIGHTS

DAY 01: BELGRADE NIKOLA TESLA AIRPORT

Arrival at the Belgrade Nikola Tesla Airport. Meeting with the guide. Transfer to hotel (info meeting and panoramic tour of the city on the way), if need help for exchange office, mobile card and etc. Dinner. Free evening, overnight.

DAY 02: BELGRADE FULL DAY TOUR – DURATION 7-8 HRS.

After breakfast 10am meeting with the guide and driver and start the City tour. Visit historical Belgrade Fortress offering panoramic views of the confluence of the Sava and Danube rivers, visit one of the largest Orthodox church in the world - The Saint Sava Church, then Republic Square, Knez Mihailo main pedestrian zone (lined with shops, cafes, and galleries, and soak in the dynamic atmosphere of Serbia's capital city). Visit old Bayrakli Mosk. Optional Lunch break. Visit Zemun old town (Millenary tower) and Danube river promenade, visit Kosutnjak forest and Ada Lake. Optional lunch. Optional visit: Museum of Yugoslav History (The tomb of the former Yugoslav president). Transfer to the hotel. Free time in the evening. Overnight

DAY 03: BELGRADE – MOKRA GORA – VISEGRAD - SARAJEVO

Breakfast. Check out and departure at 08am. Start the circle trip. Arrival at Mokra Gora village and take a short tour inside "Wooden Town" - tourist attraction In the heart of nature park, created by one of the best known movie directors, Emir Kusturica. Lunch break on the way. Continue and crossing the border with Bosnia&Hercegovina (Republica Srpska). Arrival at Visegrad to visit XVI century Old Bridge under the Drina river, UNESCO world heritage site since 2007. and visit Andric City - is a project of Emir Kusturica, the stone town inspired by the literary works and characters of Nobel Prize winner Ivo Andric. It's architecture is a mix of different eras and styles that passed throughout Visegrad history: the Byzantine style, the Ottoman period, the Renaissance, the Classicism. Continue to Sarajevo, overnight at hotel



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DAY 04: SARAJEVO – MOSTAR

Breakfast at hotel, check out. Start the tour by walk and panoramic. Sarajevo is also a town in which for more than 400 years' mosques, orthodox churches, roman-catholic churches have been standing together. The most recognizable landmark of Sarajevo is Sebilj, a wooden fountain located on Baščaršija Square, the oldest street Kazandziluk, the liveliest and historical part of the city, Gazi Husrev-bey Mosque and unique Clock tower and oldest shopping center the "Bezistan", old bazaar, City Hall, Latin Bridge and hotel Europe. Panoramic drive inside modern part of Sarajevo passing the different areas in combination with architecture of Socialist Yugoslavia. Optional lunch. Continue drive to Mostar, Short stop on the way passing Konjic small town and Jablanica lake. Optional stop Memorial Museum of Neretva river *World war II battle. Arrival at Mostar. Overnight.



DAY 05: MOSTAR – BLAGAJ- DUBROVNIK

Breakfast. Check out and start the Mostar tour walking inside picturesque Old town. Mostar is well known for its famous stone bridge built by the Ottoman Empire in 1565. It was again the great Turkish architect Mimar Hajrudin who had succeeded with the impossible mission to cross the Neretva River with a single span stone bridge (UNESCO WORLD SITE), today one of the country's most iconic monuments and a highlight of travelling in Bosnia. Optional Lunch. Continue tour and visit the Blagaj, and Vrelo Bune (Buna river Spring) natural and historical heritage include Blagaj "Tekke" (Dervish House), built right on the banks of the green Buna river. Crossing the border with Croatia. Arrival at Dubrovnik. Check in at Dubrovnik area hotel. Overnight.



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DAY 06 - DUBROVNIK

Breakfast at hotel. Explore Dubrovnik - The city of a unique history and cultural (the Dubrovnik Republic, the Statute from 1272) and inscribed on the List of World Heritage Sites by UNESCO, is one of the most attractive and famous cities of the Mediterranean. The 'Pearl of the Adriatic'. Meet the local guide for a pleasant and engaging walk through Dubrovnik's Old Town highlights. Visit Dubrovnik city walls, two kilometers long, and consisting of 17 towers, 5 bastions, two corner fortifications, and the St. John Fortress, they are Dubrovnik's main attraction. Walk up and down the Placa (Stradun), Dubrovnik's main street. Optional visit the Rector's Palace, once the seat of the government and the most important public building in Dubrovnik. A former custom building, the Sponza Palace, built in 1520, today houses town's archive that keeps the most important documents about Dubrovnik's history. Lunch on the way. Rest of the day at leisure, and free time until the evening transfer to hotel. Dinner. Overnight Dubrovnik.



DAY 07 - DUBROVNIK - KOTOR

Breakfast. Check out. Drive along the Adriatic Sea. Crossing the border with Montenegro. Enjoy in panorama scenery of the Boka - kotorska Bay, the Europe's most southern fiord. Photo stops and short break on the way at Perast village. Arrival at Kotor. Optional lunch. Embark on an unforgettable day and sightseeing starting with the charming town of Kotor, nestled in the heart of the Adriatic. Explore its streets of old Venetian town, framed by towering mountains. The town has its original appearance from the 14th century and protected by UNESCO. Optional Included boat ride to the Our Lady of the Rocks, a man-made island housing a stunning church presenting the one of the main attractions in Boka Bay. Optional Gondola Cable car tour. Drive to Budva. Check in at hotel. Free evening. Overnight.



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DAY 08 - BUDVA – PODGORICA - NOVI PAZAR

Breakfast. Check out. Explore Budva a city that rapidly expanded and developed as a center of tourism during the summer season. Visit one more beautiful old town. We continue our journey driving through the mountains with beautiful surroundings and landscapes. Optional stop on the way and lunch break at Podgorica City the capitol of Montenegro, administrative and business center. Continue driving passing the villages with mostly Muslim population. Crossing the border with Serbia. Arrival at Novi Pazar. Overnight.



DAY 09 - NOVI PAZAR - BELGRADE – Mix of Culture and UNESCO tour

Breakfast. Check out. First visit is Monastery Sopoćani, the endowment of the Serbian King Uroš from 13th century. The beauty of the existing frescoes in the temple makes Sopoćani one of the most cherished monuments of European art (UNESCO list). Explore Novi Pazar town: Visiting the old bazaar, Amir Aga Han, remains of the medieval fortress from the XV century. It stands out as the most beautiful monument and rare masterpiece of Islamic architecture Altun-alem mosque, built in the early XVI century; then Isabeg Hamam from the XV century, the legacy of the founder of Novi Pazar and one of the most prominent military leader of the Ottoman Empire Isa Bey Isakovic. Hamam is one or the few preserved in Serbia. The tour includes the old Arab mosque (XVII century restoration). Lunch break optional. Continue the tour toward Belgrade. On the way visit the Studenica monastery (UNESCO), the most important medieval Serbian monastery built from 1183-1196 - the endowment of Prince Stefan Nemanja, founder of the independent Serbian state and of a royal dynasty that ruled Serbia for more than two centuries. The most important medieval Serbian monastery built from 1183-1196, considered one of the masterpiece of central European architecture. Arrival at Belgrade hotel. Last night dinner. Overnight.



DAY 10: BELGRADE AIRPORT

Breakfast. Check out. Free time depend on flight departure time. Your driver/guide will be waiting for you in the lobby of the hotel, ready to take you to the airport, to board your flight home. End of Service.
